Dear Parents/Carers,


We are extremely excited to tell you about some fantastic new playground equipment that is being installed on our large playground next week, beginning Monday 2nd December. We are having several pieces of child-friendly gym equipment being installed which will provide the children with extra resources to help them lead an active and healthy lifestyle.

While this equipment is being installed, we will be unable to use the large playground due to the disruption caused during the installation. Unfortunately, this means that children will be unable to enter or exit school from the usual points for the duration of this week and alternative arrangements have been made, which are detailed below:

- Nursery and Reception – these year groups will be unaffected and children can be brought to school and collected from the usual points.
- Year 1 and 2 – children will enter school through the main entrance by the school office. At home time, parents will have to enter the school at 3:15, walk to their child's class to collect their child, and then exit the building through the main entrance again.
- Year 3 and 4 – children will enter school through the Early Years entrance and enter the building by our new classrooms. They will then be able to walk through the school to their correct classroom. At home time, parents will collect their children from the Early Years playground and the children will be dismissed from there.
- Year 5 and 6 – children will enter school through the main entrance by the school office. At home time, parents will have to enter the school at 3:15, walk to their child's class to collect their child, and then exit the building through the main entrance again.

If the weather is bad then the installation of this equipment will have to be delayed; if this happens, then we will inform you via text at the earliest opportunity and all children will enter school via the usual routes. We apologise for the disruption caused but thank you for working with us to help provide the children with a new, exciting resource!
